Weekly Vespers – In this service for all ages, we connect with the spirit and one another through song, prayer and story. This is a wonderful opportunity to join in a more intimate worship setting, and to have a mid-week spiritual touchstone in church community.

Parenting Today – This series is designed to facilitate conversation and mutual growth among parents with children of all ages. Some sessions are run as book groups, while others will feature guest speakers.
